In 2024, we celebrate our 60th anniversary in the UK and Ireland.

MedicAlert UK now supports over 36,000 individuals to keep them safe in an emergency and provide them with peace of mind. Last year alone, our emergency line answered over 700 calls.

Today, MedicAlert UK are working hard to continue to:

- build strong partnerships with charities that support people with numerous health conditions
- maintain an education service for all emergency services and healthcare professionals
- drive awareness amongst the public, ensuring everyone understands the importance of checking for MedicAlert ID jewellery

MedicAlert UK is based in Buckinghamshire, with a production unit creating bespoke medical ID jewellery and a member services team including in-house Registered Nurses to support our 36,000 members.

Key Responsibilities and Duties

1. Leadership

3. Governance


- With the Chair and Vice Chair ensure Board members receive appropriate, accurate advice and information to fulfil their governance responsibilities.


